The patented Völker siderail system is characterised by its exceptional versatility. It consists of separate elements that are split on both sides and can be adjusted to either one or two levels. This ensures that patients feel adequately protected from accidentally rolling out of the bed. As the siderails are highly versatile and robust, they can also assist mobilisation.

The side elements are directly integrated into the lying surface. The rails at the head and foot move with the bed as it is adjusted.



Comfortable. The Völker MiS® Micro-stimulation System.

The patented Völker MiS® Micro-stimulation System is based on neuroscience principles. It detects even minor movements made by the patient. The lying surface then feeds these back through the mattress and to the patient's body as tactile stimuli. This continuous feedback increases the patient's body perception, and promotes movement and blood circulation in the skin. Comfort is improved when the patient is sleeping or lying down, mobility is increased and the risk of bed sores is reduced.
